Care Provided in Transport: The patient was closely monitored throughout the flight. We started blood during the flight and that greatly helped increase his blood pressure while en route to the receiving facility. We administered ketamine along with some additional epinephrine to aid in ventilation and blood pressure support.

Receiving Hospital Update: Upon arrival to the receiving facility, bilateral chest tubes were inserted, but they did not remove any more blood. He was also found to have a broken left clavicle, multiple rib fractures, a subarachnoid hemorrhage, and frank blood in his urine upon Foley insertion.

Additional Information: Thank you to everyone involved who cared for this patient, and excellent job on the ET tube placement and management! We appreciate everything that you do for your community and for making a smooth and easy transition over to the helicopter.
